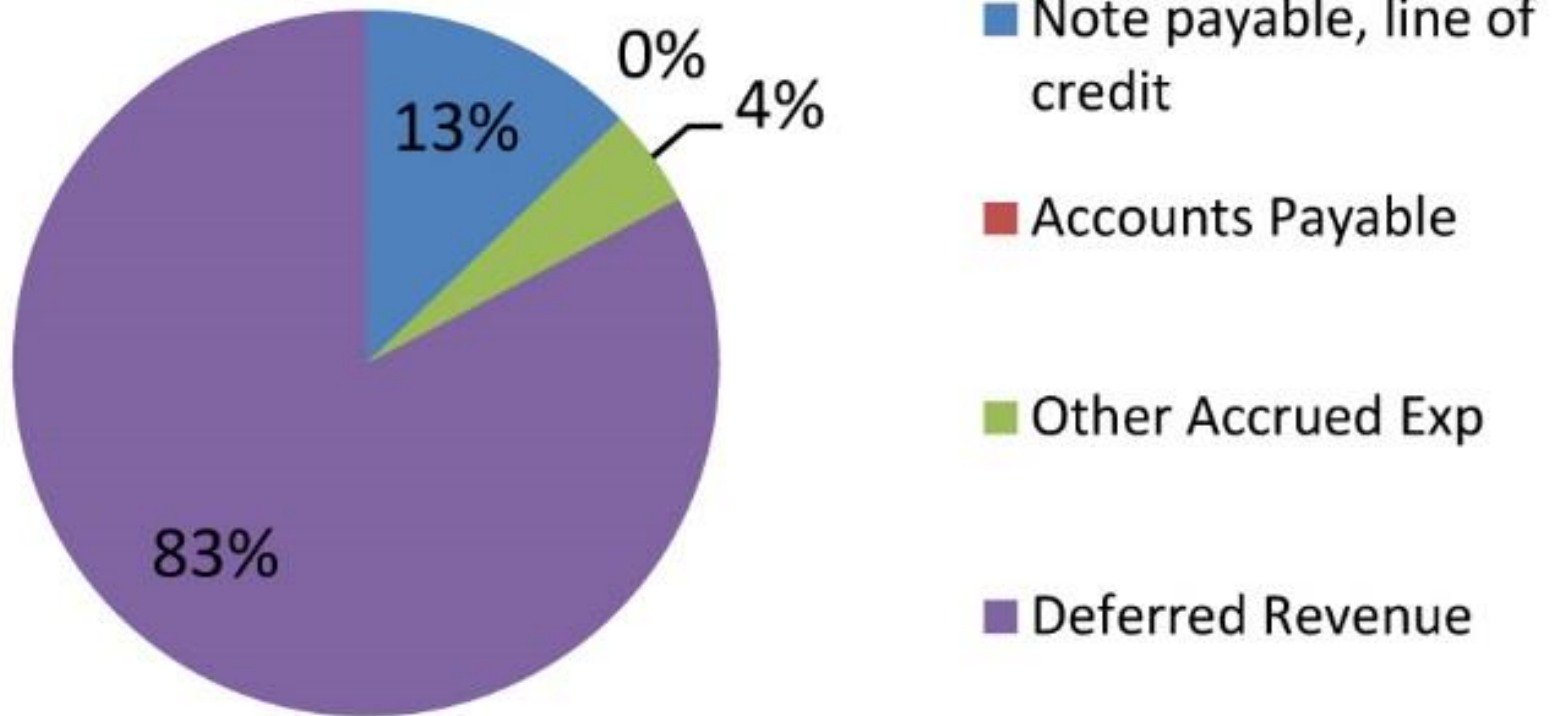

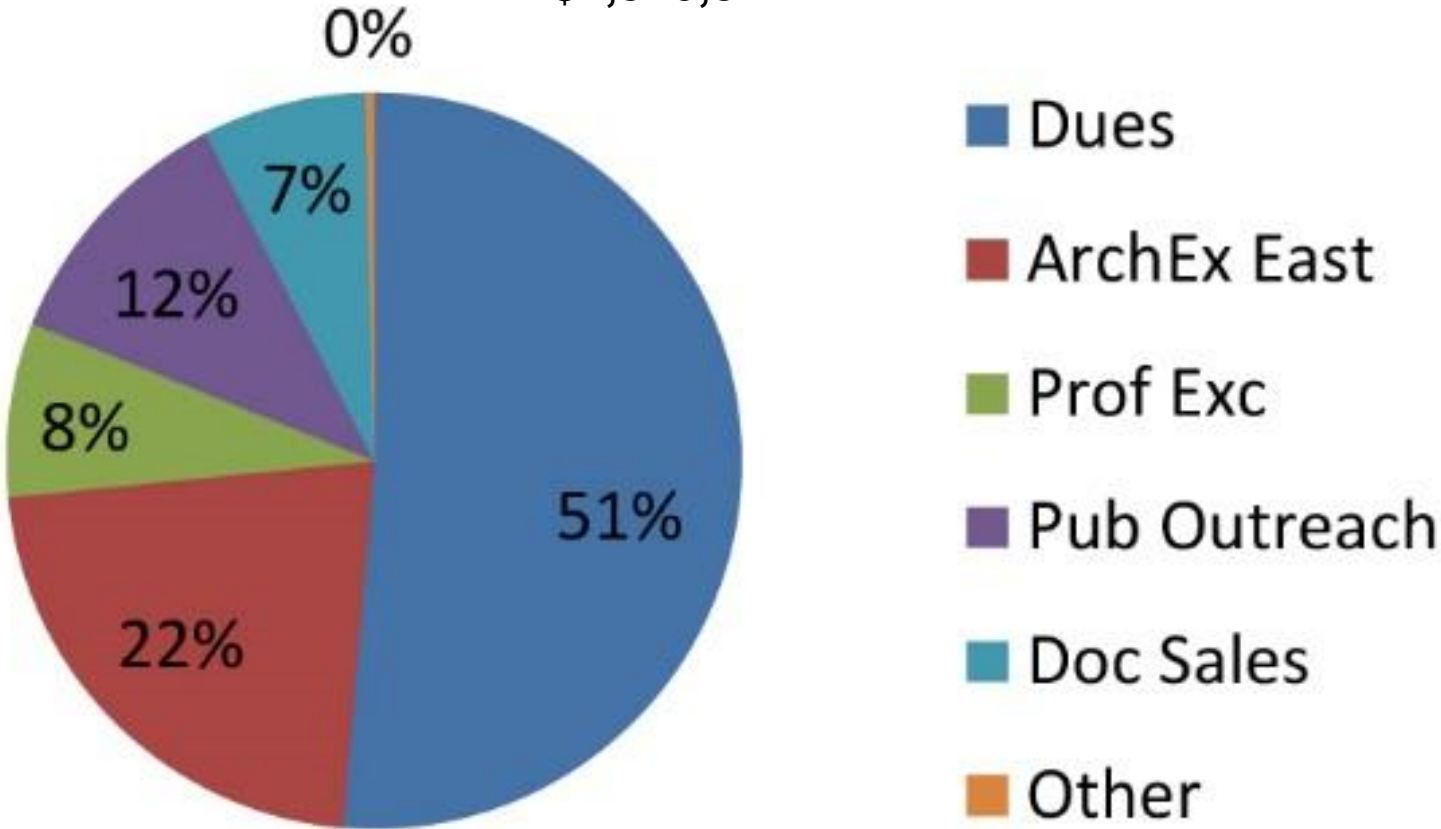

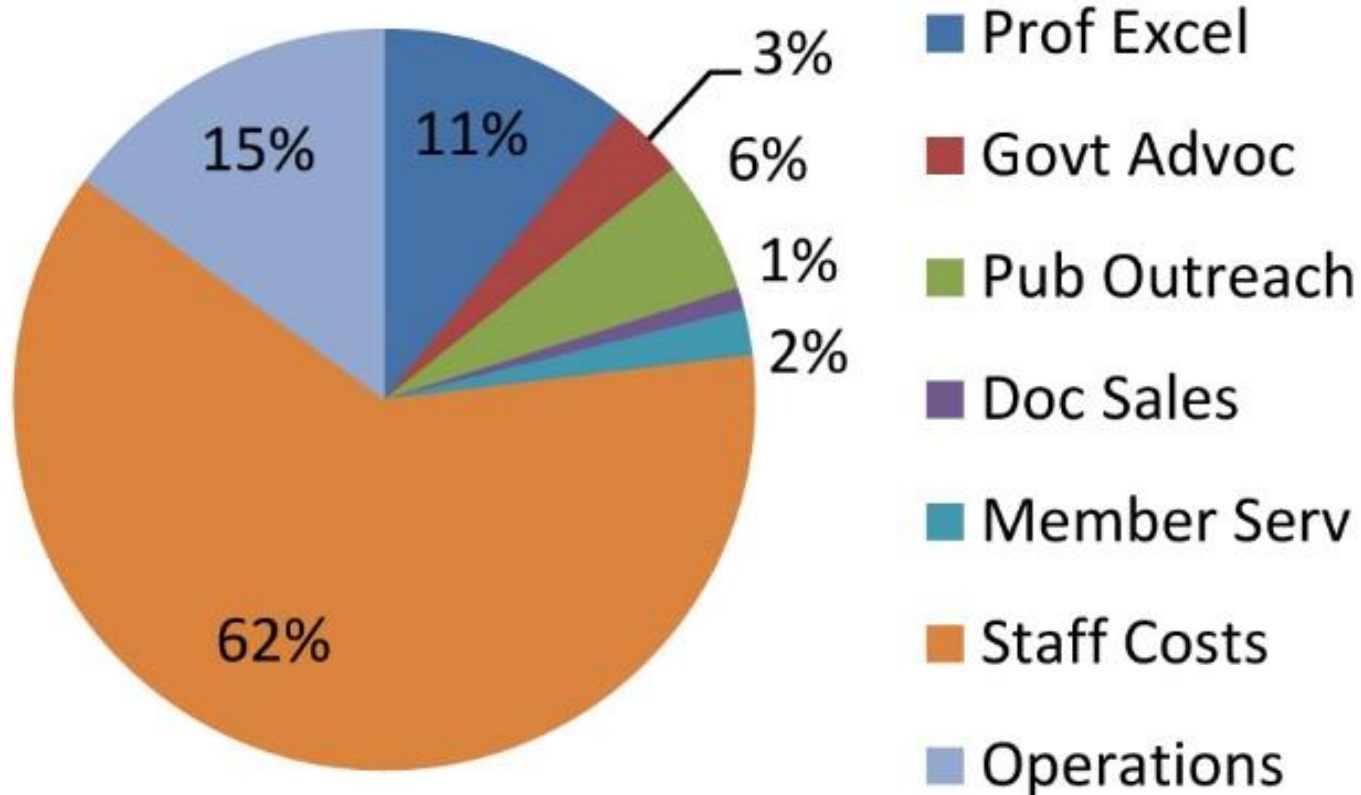
Revenue - 2013

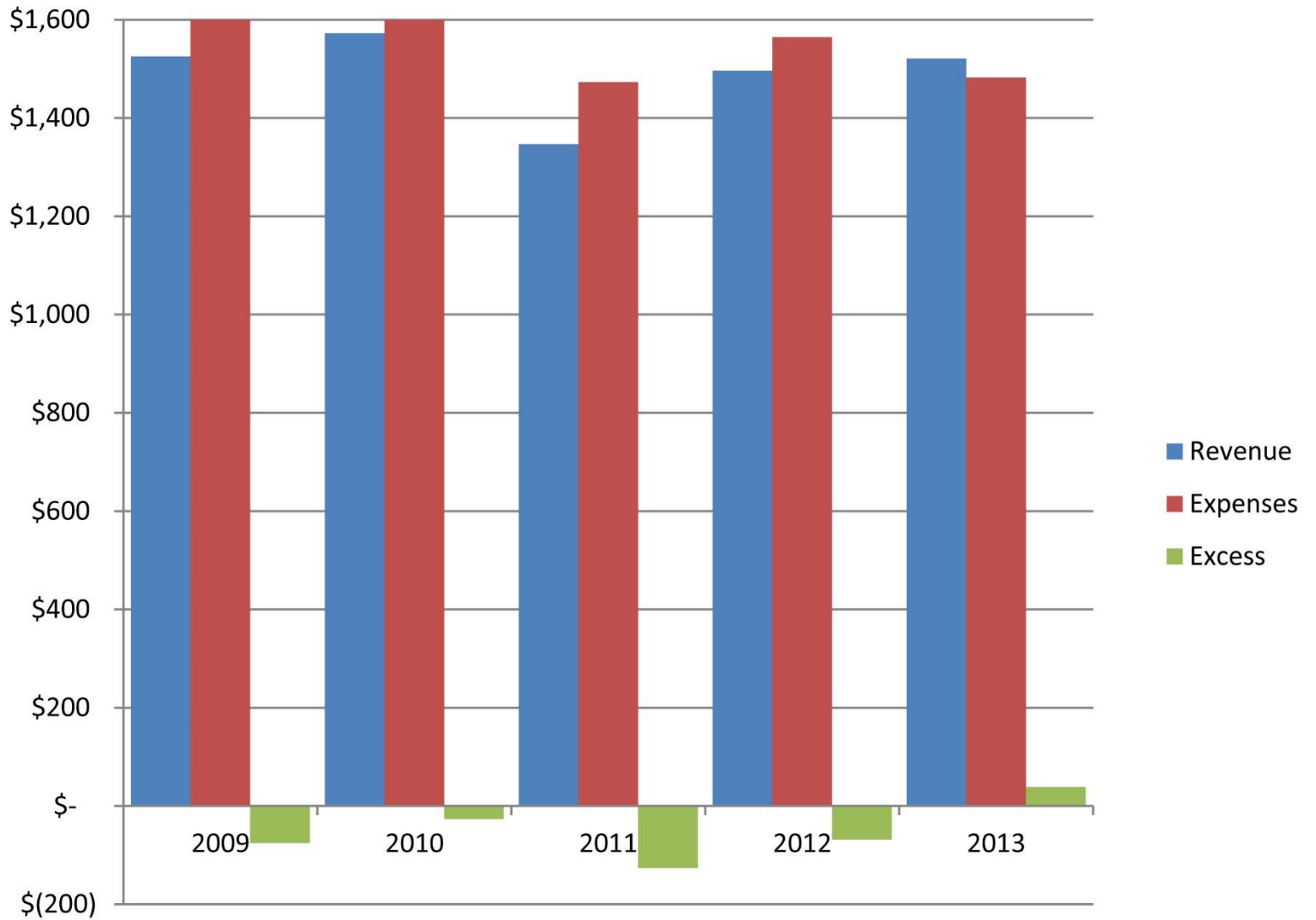


Expenses - 2013
