CRITERIA FOR GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTMENT ENDORSEMENT

Any Member seeking the endorsement of AIA Virginia for a gubernatorial appointment shall submit the following items to AIA Virginia Executive Vice President, Corey Clayborne, FAIA at cclayborne@aiava.org:

1. Submit a letter of interest on company letterhead that articulates the skills, experience and passion that would make the individual an effective board member
2. Submit a resume/CV of professional experience. Include AIA involvement and service to the profession. Candidate shall provide AIA membership and Virginia license numbers on this document.
3. A letter of commitment, signed by the firm's chief executive, indicating support of the candidate's time commitment to attend all meetings.
4. Provide a letter of support from the candidate's local AIA component
5. Provide a letter of support from an individual who can speak positively of the candidate's contributions and abilities. Examples include clients, government officials, community organizations, and professional colleagues.

Candidate must be an Architect holding a Virginia architecture license in good standing.
