## Bob Boynton Awarded the NCARB President's Medal



Bob Boynton, FAIA, was recognized for nearly 30 years of service to NCARB, and 18 years of service to the APELSCIDLA Board with the NCARB President's Medal for Distinguished Service.

In addition to serving in various leadership positions on the NCARB Board of Directors and Virginia Board, Boynton was appointed to the NAAB Board of Directors and the AIA National Ethics Council. As NCARB president in 2004, Boynton led efforts to update the ARE's content areas and expand

international practice through the Tri-National Council and APEC Architect Project Steering Committee.

This year only twelve individuals were awarded the NCARB highest honor, the President's Medal for Distinguished Service. The medals were bestowed by President David L. Hoffman, FAIA, NCARB at the organization's Annual Business Meeting.
