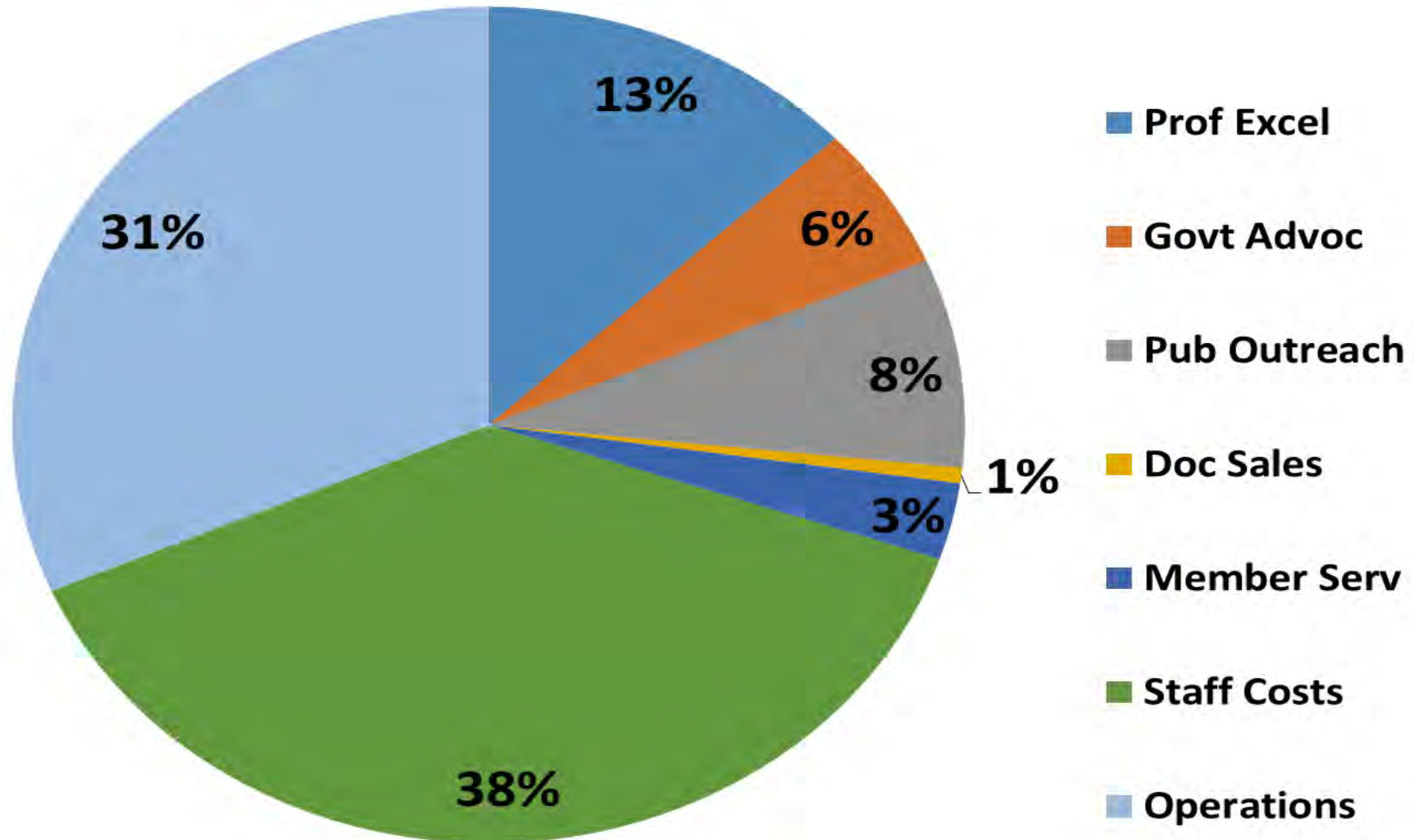

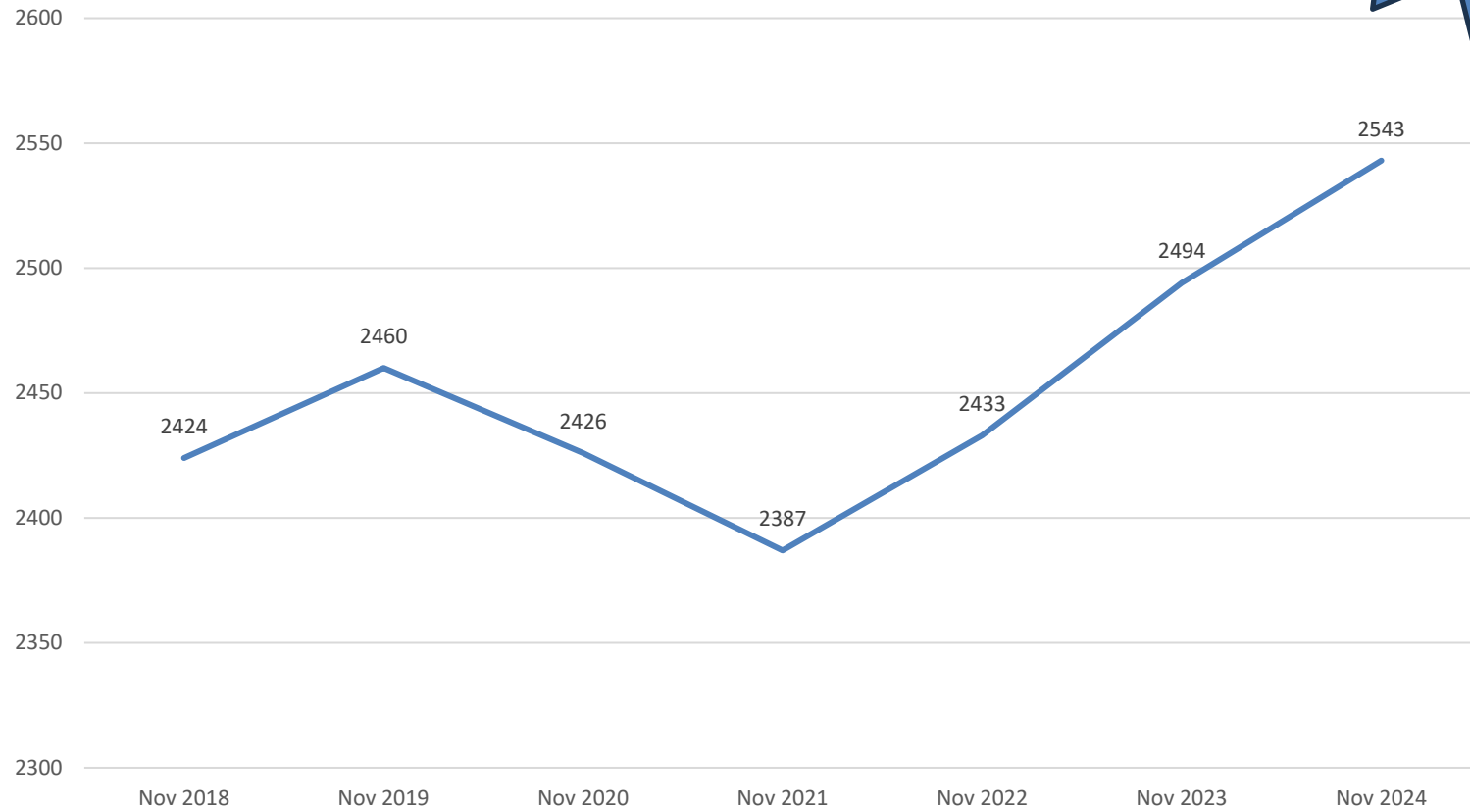

# Advocacy Advisory Council

Annual Meeting Update | Nov. 6, 2024

**Our Purpose:** The Council is responsible for reviewing and advising in the broad area of government affairs, whether on legislative, regulatory, code, or other issues at the state level. In addition, this Council makes recommendations for candidates for gubernatorial appointment.

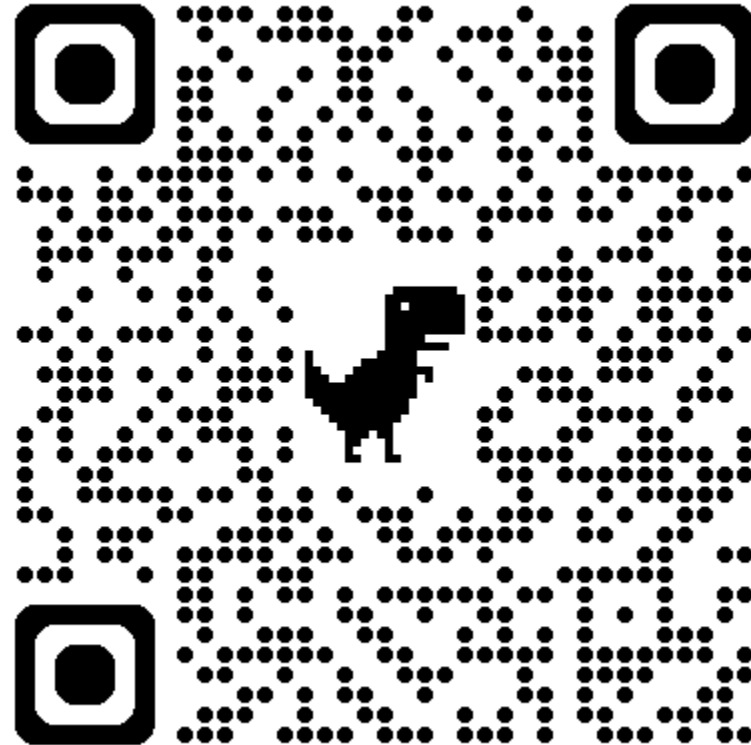

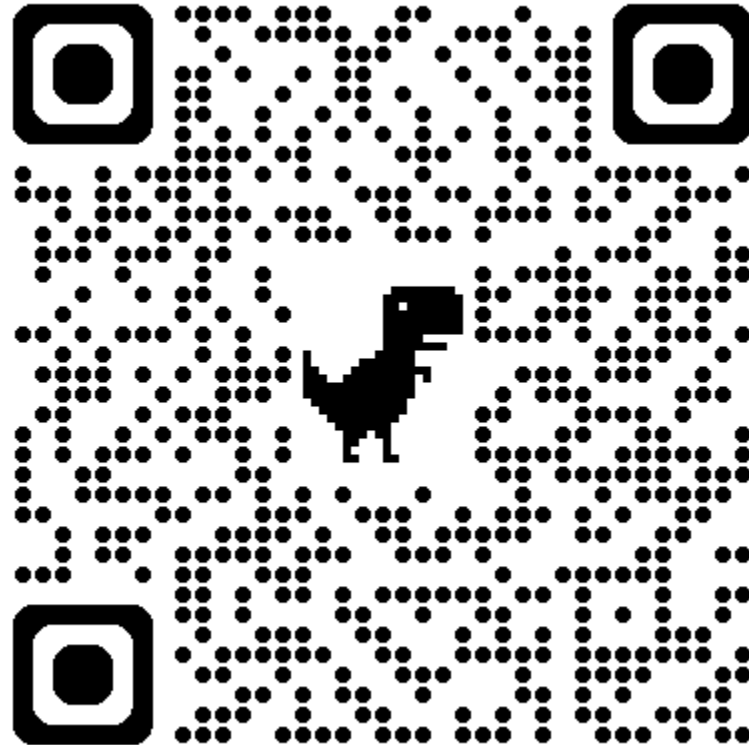

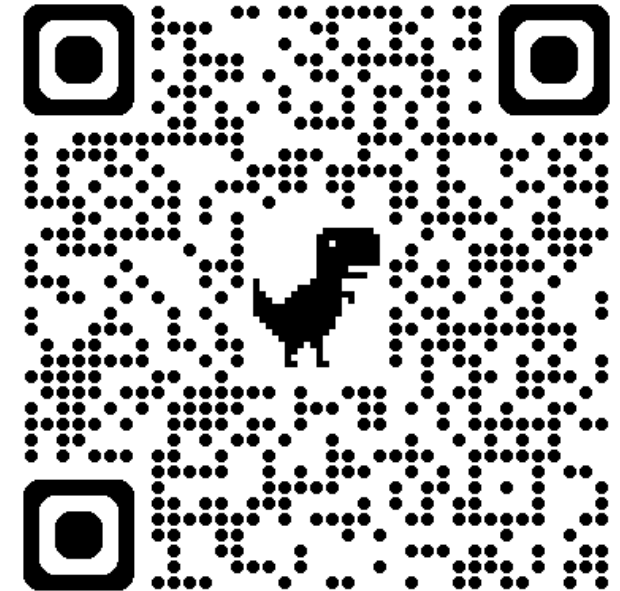
